

Cannes Film Festival Top 6 Luxury Hotels

The Cannes Film Festival starts today and continues until May 27, 2012. Luxury Travel Magazine recommends these hotels in Cannes.

A 5-star hotel in the heart of Cannes, **JW Marriott Cannes** (pictured above) overlooks the Mediterranean Sea on the Boulevard de la Croisette, a mere stone's throw from the old town, the Palais des Festivals, the old port, just 30 minutes from Nice airport. La Scena lounge bar and restaurant offers an outstanding place to see and be seen. Specialties from Italy, Japan and France are on the menu at La Scena. Creative and subtle, fine cuisine is yours for tasting.



Since its opening 100 years ago in 1912, the InterContinental Carlton Cannes is renowned as a monumental reference point in the landscape of Cannes, recognized throughout the world for its outstanding service and unparalleled location. Situated only thirty minutes from Nice Cote D'Azur Airport, in the heart of La Croisette, the most famous promenade in the world, the InterContinental Carlton Cannes offers the most breathtaking views of the Mediterranean Sea and has served as a "home away from home" for countless dignitaries and Hollywood stars alike. The hotel houses 343 guestrooms, suites and stunning salons for receptions and meetings. Built in the 1920s, the Martinez reigns over the most glamorous city on the French Riviera. From palm-fringed grounds facing the sea, the 5-star luxury hotel dominates La Croisette, the world-famous promenade. Completely renovated and redecorated in its original style. In 2001, the hotel now offers two new 500 square meters penthouse suites, with stunning private terraces overlooking the Bay.
